

Civil Marriage at the Climate House

Saturday September 12, 2026 & Saturday May 8, 2027



The Climate House is located in the Botanical garden. It is a part of the Natural History Museum at the University of Oslo and opened in June 2020. The house is built in a way that causes the least possible environmental impact and greenhouse gas emissions. [The exhibitions in the Climate House](#) offer research-based knowledge about climate and climate change. The wedding is held indoors in the Amphitheater. The price for a wedding ceremony in the Climate House is NOK 4 555.



You are welcome to bring guests, but the total number of people cannot exceed 30.

It is easy to travel by public transport to the Climate House. From Tøyen subway station, it takes around 6 minutes to walk. There are also trams and buses nearby. Please note that there are limited parking spaces in the area. The Climate House is accessible for mobility-impaired visitors.
