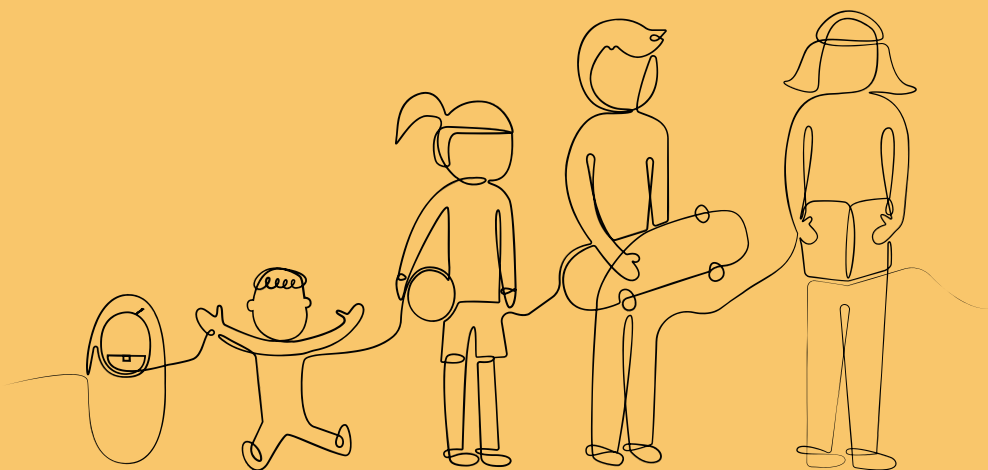

Stafettlogg – what is it?

Stafettlogg [relay log] is a **digital coordination tool** that gives you a better overview when several services are cooperating to help you/your child.



Why use Stafettlogg?

This log can make the work between the home and kindergarten/school easier and it can help when you need to cooperate with several case workers/agencies. The log gives you a clear overview of the challenges you are to work on together to find a solution and which measures you have agreed upon. Each measure has a case worker that is responsible for it and a deadline for evaluation.



How does Stafettlogg work?

The log is established when you have given your consent and want to have a Stafettlogg. The family/person in question owns the log and decides who can have access to it. To be granted access to Stafettlogg one has to log in via the internet. Everyone who has access logs in by using their own Bank-ID.



The log is put together in coordination meetings with you and the relevant services. The case worker who has the most regular contact and has the tightest follow-up of the child / pupil / youth in the services has the role of “baton holder”. This is your regular contact person and the person who coordinates the cooperation and writes in the Stafettlogg. This person will use the log to invite you to coordination meetings and to document what you have agreed on in the meetings. You can log into the Stafettlogg at any time to see what has been agreed.
